Syllabus for B.A. LL.B. Entrance Examination 2083 (2026)

1. Examination Scheme & Specifications

The entrance examination evaluates candidates across multiple disciplines to assess their linguistic proficiency, general awareness, analytical reasoning capabilities and foundational aptitude for legal studies. The comprehensive selection process is structured as follows:

- **Total Written Marks:** 80 Marks
- **Minimum Pass Threshold:** 48 Marks (Required to qualify for the interview phase)
- **Interview Evaluation:** Candidates who successfully pass the written examination will qualify for an interview session valued at 20 marks.
- **Examination Duration:** 2 Hours.

The written examination is divided into the following sections:

Group/Section	Subject Component & Target Evaluation Areas	Weightage
Group A	English Language & Comprehension • Applied legal/general vocabulary, structural grammar, tenses and syntax mechanics.	15 Marks
Group B	General Knowledge & Current Affairs • National/international governance, political shifts, fiscal metrics, treaties and socio-cultural frameworks.	20 Marks
Group C	Legal Reasoning & Aptitude • Logic sequences, directional orientation, basic deductive rules and core constitutional articles.	20 Marks
Group D	Nepali Language Proficiency • Socio-legal terminology translation, structural definitions, grammatical prefixes and phrase transformations.	15 Marks
Group E	Essay & Paragraph Writing (English & Nepali) • Long-form synthesis on contemporary legal theory, socio-tech dynamics and civic responsibilities.	10 Marks
